IMPORTANT DATES

- MONDAY 13 SEPTEMBER FIRST VACCINATION DOSE REQUIRED, proof of vaccine
- MONDAY 27 SEPTEMBER FIRST VACCINATION DOSE REQUIRED, scanned QR codes ONLY!
- **SUNDAY 24 OCTOBER** SECOND VACCINATION DOSE REQUIRED, scanned QR codes ONLY! *More on the specific requirements below...*

YOUTH VISITORS (0-18 YEARS)

Youth Participants (0-11 years)	ID <u>not</u> required	Proof of vaccination <u>not</u> required
Youth Rec Participants during class (0-19 years)	ID <u>not</u> required	Proof of vaccination <u>not</u> required
Youth Members/drop-ins (12-18 years)	ID <u>not</u> required	Proof of vaccination <u>IS REQUIRED</u> (Follow the same requirements as for adults, below)

ADULT VISITORS (19+ YEARS)

Anyone entering a Hive facility must show proof of vaccination <u>AND</u> a valid piece of government issued photo ID, such as:

- BC driver's licence or BC Services Card
- Passport
- Photo ID issued by another province or territory

MON 27 SEP - SAT 23 OCT	Valid photo ID (see above)	PLUS a scanned QR code for FIRST vaccination
SUN 24 OCT (until further notice)	Valid photo ID (see above)	PLUS a scanned QR code for SECOND vaccination

IMPORTANT Option to store vaccination status on file:

With your express consent, staff can tick a checkbox to show that we have seen your valid proof of vaccination.

- If yes, you consent, you won't have to show proof again until 24 October
- If no, you do not consent, you will be asked to show your ID and proof each time you visit

What will happen on 24 October, when we require proof of the second vaccine?

On the <u>24 October</u> all of the vaccine passport boxes will be cleared/reset, and once again we will require climbers to show ID <u>and</u> have their vaccine passports scanned to gain entry to the gym. We will wait for further government instructions on what this will look like.

What if someone has a medical/religious exemption?

At this time the government has stated **no exceptions** for optional activities/businesses. Sadly, this doesn't give us any room for discussion on the matter.

VISITORS FROM OUT-OF-PROVINCE / OUTSIDE OF CANADA

Participants visiting us who have been vaccinated outside of province/Canada will still be required to show proof of vaccination.

OUT-OF-PROVINCE	Valid photo ID (see page 2)	PLUS either; • Provincially/territorially officially recognized vaccine record • Health authority immunization records
OUTSIDE OF CANADA / INTERNATIONAL VISITORS	Passport	PLUS the proof of vaccination they used to enter Canada (eg. ArriveCAN)

HIVE MEMBERS WHO ARE NOT VACCINATED

Hive Members will be able to request a 'vaccine passport freeze'. The freeze will be <u>free of charge</u>, running from <u>13</u> <u>September 2021</u>, until the government no longer requires proof of vaccination (unless the climber chooses to unfreeze at an earlier date).

When will the freeze start?

Members may request a 'vaccine passport freeze' prior to 13 September, but <u>freezes will only be active starting 13 September '21</u>.

Who will be eligible for the free freeze?

During the first vaccination requirements, participants who have visited a Hive facility after 13 September will <u>not</u> be eligible for a 'vaccine passport freeze'. On the 24 October we will launch a second 'vaccine passport freeze', for those still waiting to get their second vaccine. More info to follow, as we receive it.

Can members use punch passes or drop-ins whilst on the 'vaccine passport freeze'?

Climbers who are set up with a 'vaccine passport freeze' will have their membership unfrozen once they visit us with an eligible vaccine passport. This means that they <u>cannot</u> choose to remain frozen and use punch passes or drop-ins instead.

What happens when vaccine passports are no longer required?

All memberships frozen under the 'vaccine passport freeze' will be <u>AUTOMATICALLY</u> unfrozen on the date that the government announces/chooses that vaccine passports will no longer be required. We will <u>not</u> be notifying members of the unfreeze. We will also clear the vaccination tickbox.

Will we be offering refunds on memberships and punch passes?

Our policy remains no refunds. Please direct these requests to the email addresses above. At this time vaccine passports are a government requirement, and we expect all members to be able to access our facilities in the future.
